2023 HSWCD Summer Poster Contest Rules & Deadlines





2023 Entry Deadline: August 31

The HSWCD Summer Poster Contest is open to children in grades K-12 for the 2023-24 school year. Winning entrants are eligible to receive one free ticket to the Hillsborough County Fair, where their posters will be on display. The 2023 fair runs Nov. 2-12 at the Hillsborough County Fairgrounds in Dover. To ensure judging eligibility, please follow all poster contest rules, noted below.

Rule 1: "Farming Feeds The Future" must appear in the artwork on the front of each poster.

Rule 2: Any media can be used, including paint, crayon, colored pencil, charcoal, stickers, paper, or other materials. Poster size must be 14-inches by 22-inches, which is half the size of a standard poster board.

Rule 3: The 2023 Summer Poster Contest Registration Form must be attached to the back of each entry. Entry Deadline is Aug. 31, 2023.

Rule 4: All posters must be created by an individual student, rather than a team of students. Entry must be the entrant's original work. **Contest Judging Criteria is as follows:**Uses and Reflects Conservation Theme (50 percent), Visual Effectiveness (30 percent), Originality (10 percent) and Universal Appeal (10 percent).
