

- Update on SB 1078/Review of Rule Making Process Report by Tompkins submitted to FDACS following action taken by Board at August 31, 2022 Board meeting.
- Current status of EPA Proposal to remove strawberries from the Thiram (currently an approved fungicide) label effective this upcoming season.
- AFCD Announcement by AFCD to change date and location of 2023 State AFCD meeting from January to February 6 – 8, 2023 at the Hilton UF, with a newly revised program (details not yet available). This was made last week of September, so all plans announced at the AFCD Quarterly meeting on September 7, 2022 are no longer valid. Quarterly meeting and workshop attended by Brookins and Tompkins.
- Education Programs

*Ag Venture – HSWCD will present pollinator program for Fall 2022 Ag Venture at Florida State Fairgrounds, October 25 – 28 and October 31 – November 4, 2022, with October 31st designated as Home School Day. This will include thousands of 3rd grade students and HSWCD theme will be "Bees, Bats, Birds, Butterflies, Our Perfect Pollinators". HSWCD will participate in Spring Ag Venture April 18 – 21, 2023.

* Poster Contests – 2022 NACD contest theme "Healthy Soil, Healthy Life", with 3 Hillsborough SWCD 1st place winners receiving top honors in state competition and advancing to the national competition. Winners will be recognized at December HSWCD Board meeting.

* Summer Poster Contest – HSWCD summer poster contest extended until October 10, 2022 with the theme; "Our Perfect Pollinators". Hillsborough County Fair has committed to same arrangement (free ticket and display for all posters) as previously provided).

- * 2023 NACD Poster Contest underway, theme "One Water". District contest open until April 28, 2023.
- *Envirothon Continuing work on competition for 2022 2023 school year.
- * Land Judging HSWCD Land Judging contest will be a traditional one, or training opportunity, based on decision of State Contest Committee regarding potential state participants.

*GS FEST –HSWCD participated in the September 24, 2022 event at the Florida State Fairgrounds, with display and distribution of over 600 water bracelet kits and flyers teaching the water cycle. Tompkins and Eckdahl worked event with almost 2,000 participants.

* Hillsborough County Fair, November 3 – 13, 2022 – 2022 HSWCD involvement in 2022 Hillsborough County Fair includes a 40' x 60' tent for HSWCD to promote "Conservation is everybody's Business" and "Bees, Bats, Birds and Butterflies, Our Perfect Pollinators". This will include an expanded youth horticulture show, expanded rain barrel competition, poster contest display, Great Plant Auction and displays by HSWCD, Operation Pollination, Rotary Brandon Global Eco, City of Tampa, Coalition of Community Gardens, Farm Bureau, NRCS, USDA, and others.

Fair Workday – October 22, 2022 – The workday will commence with a volunteer breakfast from 8 – 10 am, followed by a workday on fair booths and exhibits. Supervisors and volunteers encouraged to attend. Harvest Awards – November 3, 2022 – 11:30 am – Fair awards and recognition kickoff luncheon. Supervisors encouraged to attend (HSWCD is a previous recipient).
