

- Education Programs

\*Ag Venture – HSWCD participated in Spring 2022 Ag Venture at Florida State Fairgrounds on April 19, 21, and 22 with a program on pollinators for 320 third grade students. HSWCD will participate in Fall Ag Venture once schedule is determined.

\* Poster Contest – 2022 NACD contest theme "Healthy Soil, Healthy Life". District winning posters will compete at Area meeting on June 18, 2022.

\*Summer Poster Contest-HSWCD summer contest will be held from June 10- September 10, 2022 with the heme; "Our Perfect Pollinators"- Hillsborough County Fair has committed to same arrangement (free ticket and display for all posters) as previously provided.

\* Envirothon and Land Judging – Current plans are for both competitions to return f or 2022 – 2023 school year (provided no further COVID restriction are implemented. Plans to bring back land judging competition for 2022-2023 school year.

Director's Report, review of Overall Programs-Betty Jo Tompkins \*Hillsborough 100 Kickoff Luncheon held April 27, 2022 with approximately 140 participants at The Regent. Awards presented: were Outstanding Supporter of the Year: Duggal and Sons Farm: The Holt Family; 2022 Outstanding Volunteer Family: The Humphreys Family; Special Award: Judi Whitson, Executive Director, Hillsborough County Farm Bureau; Outstanding Project of the Year: Fancy Farms; Outstanding Cooperating Partner – Florida State Fair; Outstanding Student Conservationist: Katherine "Katie" Tyson. In addition, Katie was awarded a \$1,000 scholarship from HSWCD. The luncheon also represented the kickoff of "operation Pollination".

\*Operation Pollination - program to run from April 2022 to April 2024. Currently signing up businesses, churches, civic clubs, educational institutions, families, governmental entities. Individuals and youth groups, to conduct pollinator activities with a goal of 100 projects. Presented program to FCDEA mid-year statewide Conference – May 13, 2022 in Ocala and exhibit at Rotary District 6890 Conference May 13-15 in Lakeland. Tompkins, Katie Tyson and Mike Meegan (Rotary) have been named Ambassadors for Operation Pollination (of 60 worldwide). Receiving very positive responses thus far.

\*Hillsborough 100 Conservation Challenge tabloid – 2022 tabloid, which is 28 full color pages, published on Sunday, April 24 in the Tampa Bay Times, in TBT April 27 and will be distributed throughout the year at fairs and festivals. Total cost of tabloid to HSWCD was \$400.00 with all other costs being covered through advertising.

\*Spring Ag Tour – Supervisors Brookins and Brooks participated in the Spring Ag Tour, Friday, April 22, 2022. Tompkins could not participate due to Ag Venture presentation.

\*Clean Air Fair – HSWCD exhibited at the May 5, 2022 Clean Air Fair in downtown Tampa sponsored by Hillsborough Environmental Protection Agency.

\*FCDEA -Participated in monthly meetings and special projects.

\*AFCD – Quarterly meeting – July 1, 2022. Best Western Gateway Grand Hotel; AFCD Annual Meeting September 7-9, 2022 – Best Western Gateway Grand Hotel – Gainesville.
