Grant requests will be accepted January 10 through March 3

FUNDING AMOUNT:

Each grant recipient group will receive \$250 toward their project Grants funded through the 2022 HSWCD Great Plant Auction *Up to eight mini-grants will be awarded this cycle!*

PROJECT GROUPS:

Participating groups may be a club, chapter, troop, class or any youth group (church, civic, etc.), or any group of at least four youths with an adult supporter.



TYPES OF PROJECTS:

Programs, projects and activities may focus on any type of conservation effort, including road, river and bay cleanups; recycling of paper, plastics and electronics; wildflower and tree plantings; pollinator initiatives; community and school gardens; agricultural enhancements; wildlife habitats; and educational programs at fairs, festivals, schools and other events.

Judges will review applications, rank and award grant recipients by Tuesday, March 7, 2023
