

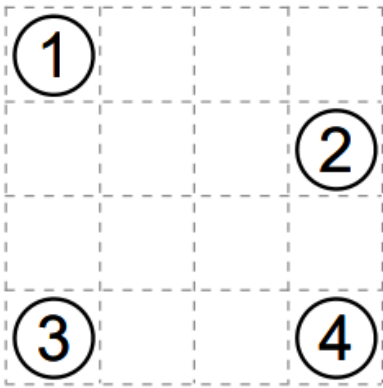

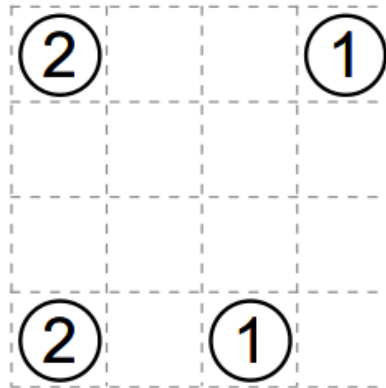
Bridges & Islands Puzzle

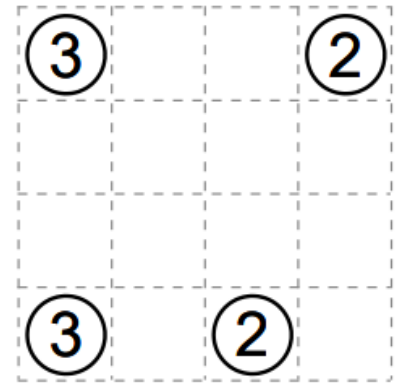

Fun Facts about Florida










In the 1920s the man-made Davis Islands were created offshore in Hillsborough Bay

Green Key and Whiskey Stump Key area are in the Hillsborough Bay and were part of the original Tampa Bay Sanctuary Islands. These islands are protected, providing necessary foraging and loafing habitats for local and migratory birds.

At only 12-feet deep, Tampa Bay is shallow and it is also the largest estuary in Florida – defined as having both salt and freshwater mixed together. Channels are dredged to allow ships to navigate the water.


Severe beach erosion near Daytona Beach from two late-season hurricanes has helped uncover what appears to be a wooden ship dating from the 1800s which had been buried under the sand on Florida's East Coast for up to two centuries, impervious to cars that drove daily on the beach or sand castles built by generations of tourists.

Homemade Fruit Snack: Frozen Yogurt Raspberries

Fresh raspberries are the perfect snack for little fingers, and we made them extra special by filling them with frozen yogurt. These frozen yogurt raspberries are so simple anyone can make them!

Course: Snack Cuisine: American
Servings: 4 Calories: 45 kcal

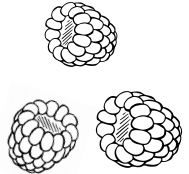
Ingredients

- 1/2 cup Greek yogurt, vanilla
- 3/4 cup raspberries

Optional: 1 teaspoon poppy seeds

Instructions

1. Fill a piping bag or ziplock bag with yogurt. You can also try using a freezer bag and snip a corner when ready. Freeze up to an hour, checking every 10 minutes. You want it to solidify a bit without becoming solid.
2. Meanwhile, rinse and dry your raspberries. Once the yogurt has thickened, pipe into the raspberries.
3. Top with poppy seeds for "sprinkles," if desired.

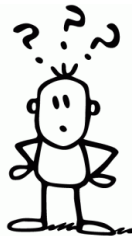
