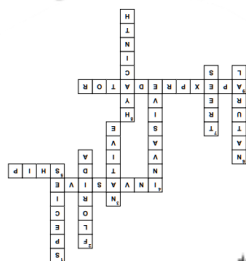
Top 10 Fun Facts about Florida
